	APPLICATION FORM: Prospective applicants are required to complete the application form seen below.
	PERSONAL ESSAY: Applicants are required to construct a comprehensive letter detailing their interests, passions, and the intrinsic motivations propelling their desire to amplify their proficiency in the specific domains offered by Whistler Adventure School. It is essential to expound upon a spectrum of activities, encompassing volunteer engagements, affiliations with community organizations, sports and athletics, artistic pursuits, musical endeavors, club affiliations, travel experiences, and any other endeavors that have contributed to the development of character, leadership acumen, goal-directedness, and an ardor for learning. The intention is to spotlight accomplishments alongside acts of benevolence. Kindly elaborate on the nature and duration of each involvement to provide a thorough understanding of your journey.
	LETTER OF REFERENCE: Applicants are also expected to provide a letter of reference. This letter should ideally be written by an individual who can attest to the applicant's character, work ethic, and suitability for the chosen program at Whistler Adventure School. The letter of reference serves as a valuable insight into the applicant's qualities and potential, helping the selection committee to gain a more comprehensive understanding of the applicant's suitability for the scholarship opportunity.
	PERSONAL VIDEO: Applicants are requested to submit a short video as part of their application process. This video provides an opportunity for applicants to showcase their personality, communication skills, and enthusiasm for the chosen program at Whistler Adventure School. The video should ideally offer insights into the applicant's background, interests, and motivations for pursuing education in the realm of Adventure Tourism.

- 2. A demonstrated dedication to active participation within their community.
- 3. A strong commitment to embracing the Whistler experience, with an envisaged alignment towards seeking employment within relevant local industries.
- 4. The ability to eloquently outline how this scholarship opportunity would serve as a catalyst for future achievements.
- 5. A genuine financial need.
- 6. Concrete instances showcasing the adept navigation of life's obstacles, whether they pertain to personal challenges, natural hurdles, or athletic pursuits.
